The purpose of this Home-School Agreement is to assist us in working together in partnership. In this way, we can help our children and young people to achieve their very best and to be secure and happy because school staff and parents/carers are working together.

School Ethos

- Provide support and strategies to meet individual needs
- Set homework where appropriate
- Keep parents and carers informed about their child's progress through:
 - Annual review and written report
 - Termly parents' meetings
 - Home-School Diary (where appropriate)
 - Newsletters
 - Verbal contact with those families who come into school to drop off/collect their child
- Let parents know of any concerns
- Positively encourage good, respectful behaviour
- Resolve any problems as quickly as possible
- Support children's learning to help them achieve their best
- Maintain effective safeguarding procedures to keep children safe

- Attend parents' evenings and other discussions on your child's progress
