SLA and CPD

During the lockdown and Coronavirus, staff have accessed CPD over Teams. This includes Outdoor and Adventurous Activity training and a number of network meetings. Staff have access to Net and Wall game training later in the Summer Term. PE coordinator has attended all subject leader meetings. Staff have also accessed dance training and Primary Teachers FA Award. This means that the Sports Premium is used on sustainable resources to upskill staff in order to deliver high quality lessons on a variety of sports.

PE subject lead has completed L2 Trampolining qualification and the other PE teacher is currently L1 trained as L2 was cancelled due to Corona virus. This has meant that Trampolining has been added to the curriculum, making it broad, balanced and personalised to the strengths of the students at Croft. It has also meant that Trampolining has been used for interventions and enrichment activities.
